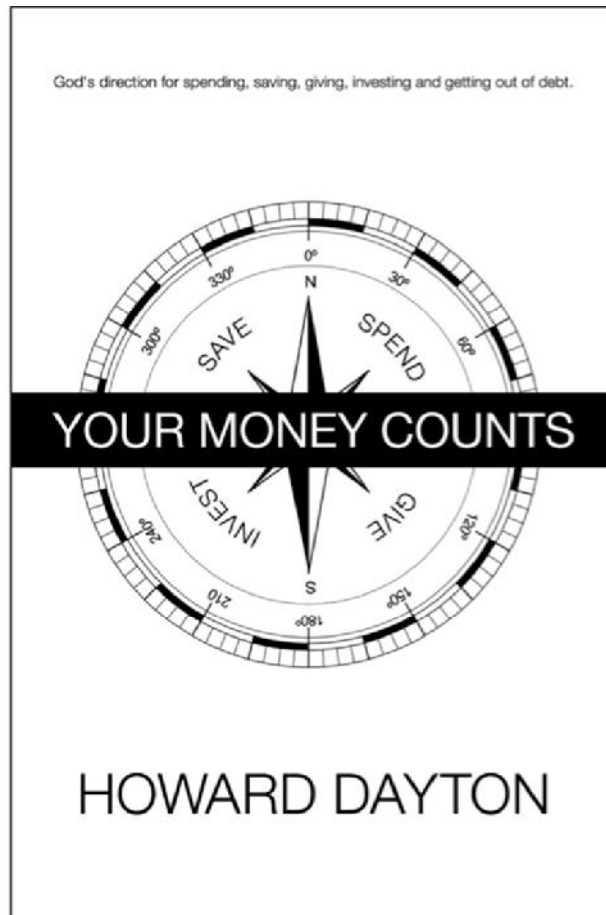
Who Will You Be?
